Monthly Plan Premium for People who get Extra Help from Medicare
to Help Pay for their Prescription Drug Costs

If you get Extra Help from Medicare to help pay for your Medicare prescription drug plan costs, your monthly plan premium will be lower than what it would be if you did not get Extra Help from Medicare. The amount of Extra Help you get will determine your total monthly plan premium as a member of our Plan.

This table shows you what your monthly plan premium will be if you get Extra Help.

Your level of extra help	Monthly Premium for Aspire Health Value*	Monthly Premium for Aspire Health Advantage*	Monthly Premium for Aspire Health Plus*
100%	\$0	\$102	\$222
75%	\$8	\$110	\$230
50%	\$16	\$118	\$238
25%	\$24	\$126	\$246

*This does not include any Medicare Part B premium you may have to pay.

Aspire Health Plan’s premium includes coverage for both medical services and prescription drug coverage. If you choose to add one of our Enhanced Benefit options, your monthly premium will be different than the amount listed above.
