



**ADDENDUM to your Aspire Health Plan Medicare Advantage
2023 Evidence of Coverage (EOC)**

Dear Member,

As an Aspire Health Plan member, we want to keep you informed about important changes to your Medicare Advantage plan that become effective during the year.

Due to the Inflation Reduction Act (IRA), there have been additional benefit changes effective later this year. The information below may or may not apply to you, but we are required to notify you of these changes.

Benefit Changes and Effective Date

Benefit	Effective Date	Benefit Changes	What does this mean for you?
Medicare Part B Prescription Drugs	April 1, 2023	Certain eligible Part B drugs, identified each quarter by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), will have reduced coinsurance. The list of drugs eligible for a reduced coinsurance as identified by CMS may change each quarter, therefore, any coinsurance reduction may be subject to change based on the updated list.	The cost-sharing for certain Part B drugs could cost less.
Insulin furnished under your Part B benefit (i.e., a medically necessary traditional insulin pump)	July 1, 2023	The cost-sharing for a one-month supply of this insulin would be no more than \$35.	If you're diabetic and on an insulin pump, you won't pay more than \$35 for a one-month supply of Part B insulin products covered by our plan.



You might not be utilizing these benefits, but as our member, we want to keep you informed any time there are changes to your plan benefits. Please keep this letter with your member documents and if you have any questions about your plan benefits, you can call the phone number on the back of your member ID card. We have also posted this Addendum to our website.

The Addendum supplements, revokes and/or supersedes inconsistent provisions of the Evidence of Coverage. All other terms in the Evidence of Coverage remain the same.
